Job Overview

The Director of Community Development is a senior management position. The individual will work collaboratively as part of the Directors team. They will provide leadership, management and mentoring support for the effective delivery and development of community development in the Renfrew-Collingwood community. Areas covered include food security, arts and culture, intercultural neighbourhood development, community connections and engagement, celebrations, neighbourhood network development, neighbourhood small grants project, sex worker safety and outreach, resiliency, social innovation, community economic development and other issues as they arise. Main duties for the position include supervising, mentoring and supporting the Community Development coordinators; leadership; Board support; human resource management; program management and enhancement; financial management; fundraising including grant applications and reporting; public relations and marketing; committee support and systems maintenance. The Community Development Director reports to the Collingwood Neighbourhood House (CNH) Executive Director.

Qualifications

- a) Minimum of 5 years of human resources and diverse community development management experience.
- b) Undergraduate degree in related field or a combination of education and work experience in community/social services, not-for-profit sector and community development.
- c) Demonstrated interest, involvement, experience and knowledge of multi-faceted community resources and programs particularly in the areas of food security, arts and culture, intercultural neighbourhood development, social innovation, sex work safety, and resiliency.
- d) Proven ability to manage an annual budget of \$600,000.
- e) Demonstrated ability to develop and work with teams, share leadership skills, work collaboratively and develop skills of other people.
- f) Ability to work cooperatively and build partnerships with residents, community organizations, funders, government and private sector.
- g) Demonstrated ability and interest in managing growth, change and interpersonal relations. Ability to work collaboratively in the integration of Community Development, Youth Services, Community Services, Early Years, Community Health Centre and Operations work.
- h) Experience in/knowledge of the Renfrew-Collingwood neighbourhood.
- i) Proven ability in grantsmanship and negotiations.
- j) Strong research and evaluation skills.
- k) Excellent organizational, communications (oral and written) and leadership skills.
- I) Demonstrated interest in and ability to work in an intercultural and economically diverse work environment.
