Volunteer Position: Community Care CSA Volunteer

Name of Program: Community Care CSA Project

Description: Community-supported agriculture (CSA) programs are direct relationships between farmers and community members that involve a subscription to a farm's harvests. As traditional CSA shares can be cost-prohibitive for many, the Community Care CSA acts as an alternative model of CSA access, with some participants paying slightly more for their share in order to ensure families and individuals with financial and other barriers can have access to high quality, fresh vegetables for a highly subsidized cost, while simultaneously supporting a local, urban farm.

Each Friday between 4-6pm from June 3-October 14, we will be delivering the Community Care CSA program in front of the CNH Main House if the weather is clear, and just inside the main entrance if it is raining.

Location: CNH Main House (5288 Joyce St); indoors if raining, outdoors if clear weather

Duties: We are looking for volunteers to help with setting up tables, tents, and food prior to the CSA pickup, helping participants select their CSA veggies and explaining their uses, and helping to take down the CSA program after it is finished.

We are also looking for volunteers to manage the Pay-What-You-Can table, including taking payments via cash and card, and inputting it in our online point of sale system.

Requirements: Availability between 3-7pm on Fridays until October 14, 2022.

As per CNH policies, all volunteers need to submit a Criminal Records Check (CRC) and be fully vaccinated (2 doses) against COVID-19 to start their volunteering experience.

Benefits: You will gain a connection to a wonderful community of volunteers and participants, learn more about CNH and its various programs, and gain skills and knowledge about various local vegetables, issues in food security, and market management.
