What is the purpose of the project?

The purpose of the project is to create a database of de-identified health information to support better research and improve the diagnosis, treatment and care of Canadians with conditions.

May I opt out of the project? YES. You do not have to allow your medical information to be used in this project. You can opt out of this project at any time. Your medical care will not be affected if you choose to not participate. To find out more, just ask your doctor, the receptionist, or our Research Network Manager.

Why is this project important? The information from this project will improve our understanding of some illnesses. We hope that the information will also help to improve doctors' care for patients. The study may not benefit you directly.

What information will be collected? This research will collect medical information about how illnesses are diagnosed or treated or managed. **We are not interested in individual level information.** We are interested in information at the aggregated level. **All personal information** including your name, address, telephone number and family contacts **will be removed before the information is added to the CPCSSN project database.**
